PATRON SAINT

Our patron saint is Saint Francis of Assisi which we celebrate our feast day in the month of October usually during the first week. Saint Francis of Assisi was an Italian Catholic deacon. He was the founder of Franciscan orders of friars minor and the women's order of St. Claire. He was the leader of the movement of evangelical poverty in the early 13th century. His concentration to poverty, charity and personal charisma drew thousands of followers. In 1979, Pope John Paul 11 recognized him as a patron saint of ecology. Due to this we chose him as our patron saint and we have a week long celebration every year to commemorate the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.
